## *Community Service* : Lyn's Medical Loan Closet



Bill Noble, Manager of Lyn's Medical Loan Closet spoke to the Rotary club about how the Loan Closet began, the work it does for the community and the volunteers that are needed to do the work.

LMLC was started by Trinity Episcopal Church from a grant obtained by the former minister for Trinity, Pastor Lyn Stabler-Tippet, who was also a member of Rotary for a short time. During this outreach project Lyn was diagnosed with Pancreatic Cancer but pressed on to make the loan closet a reality.
