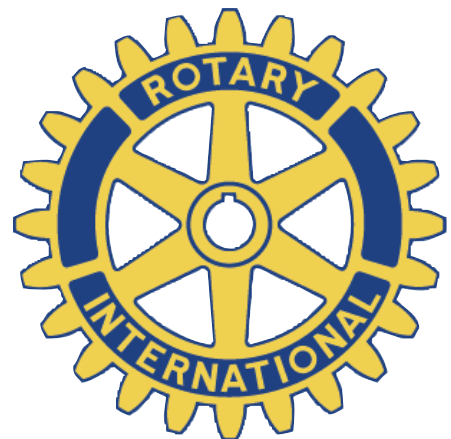

The goal is to do 70 knee replacements. Dr. Hakanson and the team help educate the local medical staff and caregivers as well as performing surgeries. Their mission is to Empower; Educate; and Engage. The WOGO team talks to girls about the importance of education setting goals. These women doctors act as role models for girls during their mission trips.

The trip begins on September 24 and the team returns October 1. We wish them much success and pray for the patients whose lives will be changed by this surgery.

Eric Leathers – Executive Director of Surry County Young Life

Young Life was formed in 1941 by Jim Rayburn and four seminarian friends. The mission began and remains today to connect with kids who are disinterested in church or don't know Jesus Christ even if they are attending church.

The local organization has grown and is working with four high schools. There are weekly club meetings in a student's home; and weekly Bible study. There are 23 properties used for kids' camps and a new one being built in Brevard, NC. More than 200 kids attend the meetings/studies and are finding new relationships along the way.

Eric grew up as a military kid never living in one place more than three years. Even though he attended church, it wasn't until a friend got to know him and help lead him into a personal relationship with Christ. Eric and his family have been living here in Mount Airy for nine years and he says this is where he would love to spend the rest of his life.
